### Camp LYNX - Leader in Training (Ages 12-13)

Our Leader in Training Program is designed to teach leadership, community, and counseling skills through hands-on experience during two-week sessions. A successful participant will have shown themselves to be enthusiastic, dedicated, hard-working, and devoted to our camp mission. Leaders in Training is a bridge program between being a camper and learning skills necessary to become a Counselor in Training in the future while being supervised and led by YMCA program staff and volunteers. Understanding that youth will be entering the program from various backgrounds and with diverse skill levels, all participants will spend time in a classroom setting learning the skills that they need to succeed in the program and be a contributing team member. All Leaders in Training are expected to present themselves as role models to campers, and exemplify the core values of the YMCA including caring, respect responsibility, and honesty. Our Leaders in Training are expected to be willing to participate fully in all camp programs and activities, and be a positive influence on the camp community
